WRAP UP OF BULLDOG BAGS FOR 2020 - 2021

Due to the hybrid school schedule during school year 2020-2021 Bulldog Bags, Inc. could not operate under its original model of packing and distributing Bulldog Bags on Fridays, so that the children could have weekend food to replace the food that they would have received on the Free and Reduced Meal Program. Instead they were packed on Tuesdays, so that all of the eligible children would receive their bags of food during the same week....Bulldog Bags became supplemental food for the children, whenever it was needed.

- 11,112 Bulldog Bags were packed and distributed
- 617 is the average number of Bulldog Bags packed/ distributed two times a month
- 18 packings/distributions
- Average of 12 items in a Bulldog Bag
- 40,749# was the total weight of the Bulldog Bags
- \$44,486.19 was spent on the 18 packings (\$2,471.46 average per packing)

Due to the guidelines regarding allowable people in a group, food was set-up and Bulldog Bags were packed by about 12 dedicated volunteers.

Another group of dedicated volunteers delivered an average of 51 bins to the schools each packing (924 bins total for the 18 packings)!

Thank you to all of the volunteers and donors who provided the money and time to help address food insecurity in our SMF students!

BULLDOG BOXES OFF TO A GREAT START

Bulldog Boxes, the summer program of Bulldog Bags, Inc., provides a box of fresh, frozen, and-non-perishable food items to families of children who receive Bulldog Bags during the school year to help them stretch their summer food budgets! One box of food in FAMILY-SIZED portions is provided one time a month, June, July and August, to families who register. The Box has 10 meals/snacks.
